#### **Description about camp:**

- Article 21A – Right to Education.

**Description about camp:**

AIDS is not a single disease but its Virus destroy our immune system that is why if any diseases caught in our body it cannot be cured be immune system was destroyed by HIV Virus. Every person living with HIV has access to quality care and treated with dignity. Effective prevention care and support for HIV patients/AIDS is possible in an environment where human rights are respected and where those infected or affected by HIV/AIDS live a life without stigma and discrimination.

We organize stop AIDS awareness camps at two different locations of Bihar & Delhi. In camp Dr. Kumar Vimal provided information regarding HIV Virus. According to him Bihar is



sitting on the time bomb of AIDS epidemic. According to a recent survey HIV prevalence rate in Bihar is about five times higher than what was believed to be and eight populous districts in the state are in grip of HIV epidemic. In survey, it reveals that mostly people at the age of 24 to 45 were sufferers.

Bihar is one of the poorest state of the country and hence among the biggest supplies of migrant labourers.

According to Sh. Ashok Kumar Yadav, some prevalence rate of Bihar District is given below: -

Dr. Zeba Khan provide a prevalence rate in the camp in Delhi, according to her people must give focus on the major symptoms of HIV which includes loss of appetite, drastic loss of weight, emaciation fatigue and lethargy susceptibility to allergies and contiguous diseases like skin irritation bronchial disorders, often leading to tuberculosis of the lungs damage to the intestinal flora resulting in diarrhea, dysentery gastritis and fluctuation in the body temperature, prolonged fever, sleeplessness etc. and precaution of AIDS includes Safe Sex, needle exchange program, treating those who are infected and male circumcision.
